- o We disseminate a monthly e-newsletter to our members that includes AHA news, community updates, and a Partner Spotlight.

- o The 2017 Kids Convening and 2017 Senior Forum SOLD OUT, with more than 100 registrations.
- o Representatives from more than 125 organizations participate on AHA work groups and task forces.
- o Quarterly Community Meetings consistently attract 75-100 participants

Sustainability Strategy

Our goal is to raise \$100,000 through affiliate memberships and sponsorships, contributed by organizations and businesses located in and serving the Aurora community. These funds will be used to support and sustain AHA's core staff and operations.

AHA is committed to keeping its fixed costs low. We do this by contracting for staff, rather than employing staff, which also allows us to be nimble in acquiring the skills and expertise we need as projects arise. We also do not maintain a physical office for AHA, which saves fixed costs like rent and utilities, and affords us the opportunity to partner with many organizations throughout Aurora in hosting meetings and events.

Once we can demonstrate that AHA's base funding comes from the community we serve, we'll be better able to negotiate for and secure grants and fee-for-service dollars to supplement our services and specific projects.
