Background and Data Context



AHA works collaboratively to improve access to care and create a healthier Aurora by increasing access, expanding coverage and building collaboration!



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
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This demographic profile was created for Aurora Health Access' Immigrant and Refugee Children's Health Task force, a subgroup of the health alliance's Pediatric Access Work Group. The aim was to fill a gap in immigrant/refugee demographic data for the 80010, 80011, 80012, 80017 zip codes in North Aurora in order to better understand the community and address relevant issues.

Market Area & Map Data Representation

For this profile we grouped census tracts into four zip codes in North Aurora to find totals for the combined area. The range breaks are calculated using a data classification method called quantile classification¹that distributes the census tracts into equal groups of 20%.


Market Area: North Aurora



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


Market Area: North Aurora

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
State School District Boundaries



The majority of the market area includes Adams-Arapahoe School District, with small parts of Cherry Creek and Denver County.

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
% Of Children with Limited English Speaking Ability (ages 5 to 17)



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
% Of Adults with Limited English Speaking Ability



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
Foreign Born Population and Citizenship Status



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
Children in Poverty with Foreign Born Parent(s)




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


% Foreign Born Population by Region




% Foreign Born Population from Africa





% Foreign Born Population from the Americas



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
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Foreign Born Population Place of Birth



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
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The largest share of place of birth for the foreign-born population in North Aurora is Mexico at 53% of the total foreign born population.




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

% Births to mothers from Mexico & with Late or No Prenatal Care



Total Births Tracked by Mother's Birth Place






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






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Total Births Tracked by Mother's Birth Place 2007-2013 Other Nations Trends

Respondents who reported speaking a language other than English were asked to indicate their English-speaking ability based on one of the following categories: "Very well," "Well," "Not well," or "Not at all." Limited English speaking in the map is defined as "not well" or "not at all".

Respondents were asked to select one of two categories: (1) in the United States, or (2) outside the United States. In the American Community Survey, respondents selecting category (1) were then asked to report the name of the state while respondents selecting category (2) were then asked to report the name of the foreign country, or Puerto Rico, Guam, etc.

Respondents were asked to select one of five categories: (1) born in the United States, (2) born in Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, or Northern Marianas, (3) born abroad of U.S. citizen parent or parents, (4) U.S. citizen by naturalization, or (5) not a U.S citizen. Respondents indicating they are a U.S. citizen by naturalization are also asked to print their year of naturalization. People born in American Samoa, although not explicitly listed, are included in the second response category.

Poverty statistics in ACS products adhere to the standards specified by the Office of Management and Budget in Statistical Policy Directive 14. The Census Bureau uses a set of dollar value thresholds that vary by family size and composition to determine who is in poverty.

⁵**Region vs. Nation:** Prior to 2006, CDPHE collected data based on region instead of individual nation. After 2007 we have the ability to track by individual nation.
