

University of Colorado Interagency Agreement Increasing Access to Care

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IA Objective

The Department will partner with the University of Colorado School of Medicine (CUSOM) to improve access to primary and specialty care for Medicaid members in Colorado.

Timeline

- **May 2016:** HB 16-1408 signed by Governor
- **July 2017:** State Plan Amendment Approved by CMS
- **FY 17-18: Building Year**
 - **November 2017:** Executed Interagency Agreement
 - **February 2018:** Program Managers hired for CUSOM & HCPF
 - **May 2018:** Community Needs Assessment Complete
 - **June 2018:** Project Plan developed
- **FY 18-19:**
 - **September 2018:** Amendment signed & Projects begin access to care work

Payment Methodology



Department of Higher Education provides 62 million to HCPF



HCPF draws down funds to match 62 million



Funds are returned to CUSOM



CUSOM allocates 62 million for Interagency Agreement

- HCPF's Special Financing team provides quarterly payments to CUSOM
