Aurora Health Alliance is one of Colorado's 25 health alliances. While health alliances have different structures, priorities, and goals, they generally have these factors in common.





### Focus on Improving Access to Care

Most alliances formed around an interest in improving access to health and healthcare services for their community.



# Geographically Focused

Most all health alliances are focused on a specific geographic area, such as a city, county, or region.



**Multi-Sector, Multi-Stakeholder** Health alliances bring together a robust mix of stakeholders -- public and private sectors, hospitals and schools, community organizations and advocacy groups, etc.



## **Community Responsiveness**

Health alliances have a process by which their members and/or their community can identify issues to be addressed.



#### Neutral Conveners

In a competitive environment, health alliances create a neutral table around which stakeholders can convene to identify and understand issues and (hopefully) resolve them together.



#### **Driving Systems-Level Change**

As a statewide network, health alliances work collaboratively to address large, system-level healthcare challenges.
